Fees and Government Funding

- Sessions not covered by government funding are charged at the hourly rate, which will be confirmed to you with your offer of a place. This is usually reviewed each April/May and is currently £ 5.28 per hour.
- Eligible working families of 2 year olds are able to claim up to 15 hours per week government funding.
- Some <u>2 year olds</u> (where income is below a specific level and the family is in receipt of certain benefits). are able to claim up to 15 hours per week government funding. Eligibility to claim this government funding is usually confirmed by a local Children Centre.
- All children who have turned <u>at least 3 years old</u> by 31st August, 31st December, 31st March are are able to claim up to 15 hours per week government funding <u>the following term</u>. e.g. child turns 3 by 31st August, can claim from September.
- <u>Eligible working families of 3 and 4 year olds</u> are able to claim up to 15 additional hours per week government funding (maximum 30 hours).
